Article 1 Introductory provisions

1. In connection with Directive of the University of Chemistry and Technology, Prague No A/S/961/7/2023 on Providing the option to continue studying upon termination of accreditation (hereinafter referred to as the 'Directive'), this Dean's Decree (hereinafter referred to as the 'Decree') stipulates the details of the organisation and conditions under which the Faculty of Chemical Technology (hereinafter referred to as "FCHT") will provide students in doctoral study programmes the option to continue studying in the same or similar study programme (hereinafter referred to as the 'successor study programme') in the event of termination of accreditation of the original doctoral study programme (hereinafter referred to as the 'terminating study programme').

Article 2 List of study sub-programmes of terminating doctoral study programmes for transfer to relevant successor doctoral study programmes

1. In a resolution of 12 December 2023, the Internal Evaluation Board of the University of Chemistry and Technology, Prague (hereinafter referred to as 'IEB') has approved an offer of successor doctoral study programmes in connection to the terminating doctoral study programmes. The table with the list of successor study programmes in which the students in terminating study programmes can continue to study under the conditions stipulated in this Decree is given in Annex 1 to this Decree.

Article 3 Date and conditions of continuation

1. In compliance with Article 5, Para 1, letter c) of the Directive, the date for inclusion of students in terminating study sub-programmes in successor study programmes in accordance with the table provided in Annex 1 is set on 1 January 2025.
2. In compliance with Section 49, Paras 5 and 6 of Act No 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to Some Other Acts (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act'), the dean will ensure the publication of conditions for the admissions procedure and the deadline for submitting study applications to the successor study programmes. The conditions of the admissions procedure will be approved by the Academic Senate of FCHT before the announcement of the admissions procedure in compliance with Section 27, Para 1, letter e) of the Act.

3. The faculty will not accept applications to successor study programmes submitted by students enrolled in terminating study programmes who, on the last day of the deadline for submitting study applications, are participants in proceedings to terminate studies pursuant to Section 56, Para 1, letters b), g) and h) of the Act.
4. Also study applications submitted by students whose studies, on the last day of the deadline for submitting study applications, have been interrupted pursuant to Section 54 of the Act and Article 12 of the Study and Examination Rules of the University of Chemistry and Technology, Prague (hereinafter referred to as 'SER') will be accepted.
5. Prior to the announcement of the admissions procedure, the faculty will ensure the preparation and distribution of individual offers to students in the terminating study programme with the possibility of continuing in a successor study programme or successor study programmes if there are alternatives (hereinafter referred to as the 'offer'), including the conditions under which it can be done. The offers will be distributed to students in the form of a document through the Study Information System of UCT Prague (hereinafter referred to as 'SIS') and also to their email address given in SIS.
6. The student does not have to accept such offer and submit their application to the admissions procedure. In this case their studies will be terminated on the date of termination of accreditation pursuant to Section 56, Para 1, Letter d) of the Act.
7. For purposes pursuant to Article 4 of the Directive, study in a terminating study programme and study in a successor study programme shall be considered one continuous study.
8. The successor study programme may require a change in the individual study plan (hereinafter referred to as 'ISP'). If this is the case, an individual study plan to complete the studies will be prepared. Study plans to complete the studies will be put together and approved by the study board of the successor study programme during the admissions procedure. Guarantors of the successor study programme will make sure, in accordance with the methodology for recognition of completed study obligations approved by the study boards, that the conditions of the successor study programme the students will have to fulfil during their studies will not be made more difficult due to the transfer to the successor study programme provided the students complete the study programme in a regular manner, unless the need to make the conditions more difficult is forced by the need to apply standards of the accreditation of the successor study programme in accordance with Government Regulation No 274/2016 Coll., of 24 August 2016, on Standards for Accreditation in Higher Education (Article 37, Para 4 of SER).

Article 4 Final provisions

1. I hereby authorise the vice-dean for science and research to interpret the individual provisions of this Decree.
2. I hereby charge the head of the Dean's Office with the performance of the organisational tasks connected with the execution of the individual measures in this Decree.
3. The head of the Department of Education and the head of the Dean's Office will together be responsible for the administration of the admissions procedure and admission of students.
4. At the same time, the head of the Department of Education and the head of the Dean's Office or an authorised employee at the Dean's Office will carry out the necessary tasks in SIS and take other necessary steps to monitor and evaluate studies of students admitted to successor study programmes.
5. The annual evaluation of students will be discussed and approved by the study boards of the successor study programmes.
